Extension to Rolls-Royce Total Care Services Agreement

Alliance Aviation Services Limited ("Alliance") today announces that it has executed an extension and expansion of its Rolls-Royce Total Care Fractional Power Agreement.

This agreement supports the 46 engines on Alliance's fleet of Fokker 100 aircraft.

Under this agreement operational risk for major engine maintenance, unplanned engine maintenance and shop visits rests with Rolls-Royce.

This amendment builds on an 18 year relationship and will operate and will operate until at least 2024 with an option to extend to December 2026.

Alliance Chief Executive Officer, Mr Lee Schofield, commented, "Rolls-Royce has been a long term strategic partner of Alliance since the company's inception. The execution of this extension agreement is fundamental to Alliance's ongoing focus on our three core values of safety, operational reliability and financial sustainability."
